

Edinburgh Christmas Market

Friday 4th - Sunday 6th December 2009



Friday Depart from Bradford at 8.00 am for the journey north, with a stop en route, before we head cross county through Teviotdale to the town of [Melrose](#), with its engaging mix of small shops and cottages, and perhaps the most famous ruined abbey in Scotland - where the heart of Robert the Bruce was buried. We arrive at the hotel in time to settle in and enjoy your evening meal.

Saturday With such a centrally located hotel, today is your own to explore the ancient city of [Edinburgh](#) with its shops, Castle and many attractions - one of which is the chance to sample the delights of its [Christmas market](#).

Sunday Taking the scenic route home through the Borders, our first call is at [Jedburgh](#), with its ruined abbey and visitor centre portraying its turbulent past and links with Mary Queen of Scots. We continue south through Redesdale in the Northumberland National Park to the city of [Durham](#), with arrival back in Bradford expected for mid evening.
