Wednesday 9th - Friday 11th December 2009

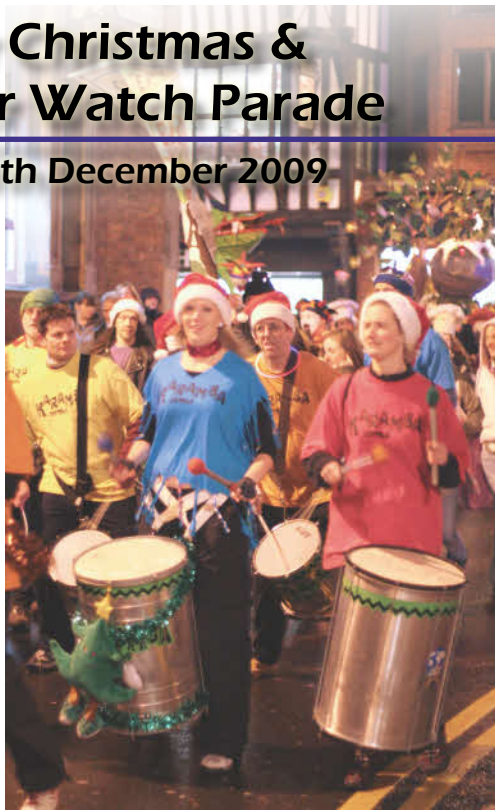
