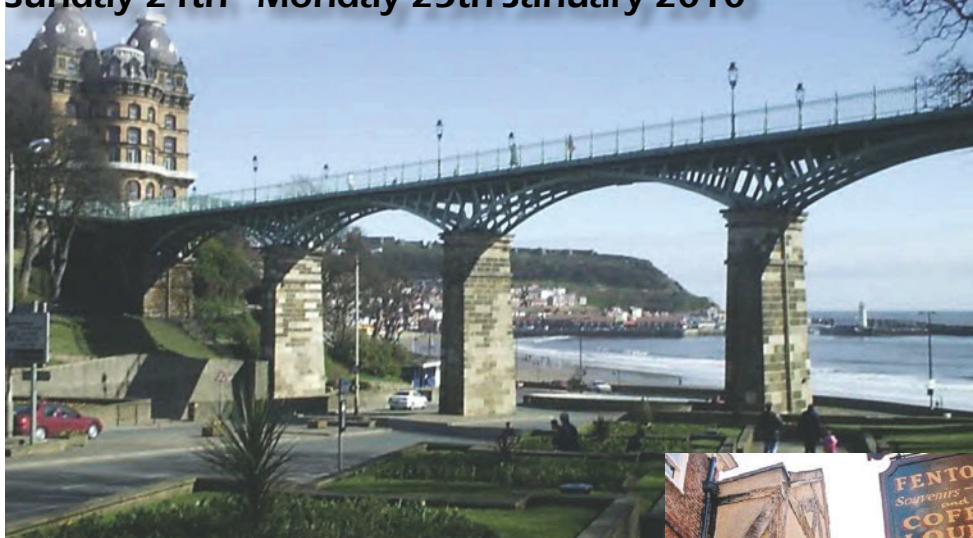


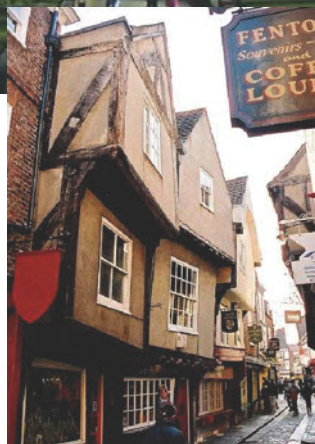
Scarborough, York & Helmsley

Sunday 24th - Monday 25th January 2010



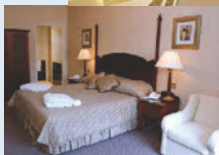
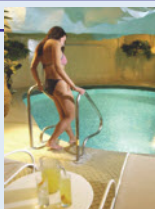
