

Severn Valley Railway & The Black Country Museum

Saturday 27th - Sunday 28th March 2010

Saturday Departing from Bradford at 8.30am we travel south with stops, as required, to the carpet town of Kidderminster where we will board a steam train on the [Severn Valley Railway](#) for the journey to the historic town of [Bridgenorth](#). Once a thriving river port, it has a host of attractive shops and buildings, a leaning castle and even a cable railway. With time to explore we will spend the afternoon here before moving onto our hotel and dinner.



Sunday The day starts at the birthplace of the industrial revolution with a visit to the [Ironbridge Gorge](#), where along with the worlds first iron bridge are museums and attractions (admissions not included) and riverside walks. In the afternoon we will visit the award winning [Black Country Living Museum](#), where a Victorian working town has been recreated, and populated with characters from that era. Return home for early evening.
