

# Free Time in London

**Saturday** Departing from Bradford at 9.00am, we will travel south with stops en route to arrive in [London](#) for early afternoon. After checking into the hotel you will then be completely free to enjoy and explore the city just as you choose. We have deliberately chosen a very central hotel for you, so that although many attractions will be within easy walking distance, there are also very good transport links via the tube, the bus, taxi or even by rail, so that what ever your interest, it is within easy reach.

**Sunday** After an English breakfast at the hotel, following feedback from previous tours, again we have left the day completely free for you to make your own choices of itinerary. Perhaps you might want to visit an art gallery, or a museum, or a cathedral or to have a blitz on the shops. Perhaps you might want to take a flight on The Eye, or you might want to take in a West End Show - the time is free for you to decide.

**Monday** After Breakfast you will need to take your bags to the luggage room, but then you will have until mid afternoon to continue your exploration of the city's delights. We will then depart from the hotel for our return journey to Bradford, arriving back for mid evening.
