

# Cornish Coast & Lands End

Monday 3rd- Friday 7th May 2010



**Monday** Depart Bradford 08.00am for the journey south to Cornwall. Stops en route as required.

**Tuesday** This morning we take a ride on the [Bodmin & Wenford Steam Railway](#) running through some delightful countryside. Before continuing via the [Camel Valley](#) to the quaint fishing village of [Padstow](#). Afternoon in resort.

**Wednesday** Situated on the most westerly point of Britain, we visit [Lands End](#) to admire the spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean. (*Admissions to Lands End attractions not included*). We continue on to [Penzance](#) renowned as a pleasant resort with a mild climate, **OR** we can offer the chance for you to visit [St Michael's Mount](#) which rises dramatically just off the coast. Access is by boat and is weather dependant (*Admissions not included*).

**Thursday** We make morning visit to the harbour village of [Boscastle](#) situated in an area designated for its outstanding beauty. We continue on to ruins of [Tintagel Castle](#) situated on the rugged and dramatic Atlantic Coastline, a place of magic, myth and former stronghold of the Earls of Cornwall. *NB Many of the paths are uneven and the site has several cliffs.* Afternoon in resort.

**Friday** We travel back north with stops as required including a break at [Evesham Garden Centre](#) around lunchtime. Arrive back mid evening.



## The Hotel
