

The Fells and Lakes

Friday 14th - Sunday 16th May 2010

Friday Depart Bradford 09.30am heading north for our first stop in the delightful village of [Kirby Lonsdale](#). The journey then takes us through stunning Dales scenery via [Sedburgh](#), and into the Cumbrian Fells, with a call at the town of [Appleby](#). On then to our popular hotel surrounded by the dramatic Shap Fells.

Saturday Heading for the main focal point of the Lake District, [Bowness on Windermere](#), with a leisurely [cruise on the lake](#) to admire the scenery travelling to Lakeside, followed by a [steam train ride](#), rejoining the coach at Haverthwaite. The afternoon will be spent in [Kendal](#) which regards itself as the Gateway to the Lakes.

Sunday We travel north today to view the breathtaking northern Lakes with a first stop at the busy hiking centre of [Keswick](#). From there we head down the centre of the Lake District ending up at [Coniston](#) and a ride on the famous [Steam Yacht Gondola](#), the perfect way to view Coniston's spectacular scenery. We return via the southern lakes with a call at [Settle](#) on the way. Arrive back mid evening.
