

Southport & Manchester Ship Canal Cruise

Sunday 13th - Monday 14th June 2010



Sunday Departing from Bradford at 9.30am we will travel via the Pendle Hills to **Southport**, where you can spend the afternoon in this delightful seaside resort. From our centrally located hotel it is easy to take a stroll along the promenade, to take a ride on the Miniature Railway, explore the Botanic Gardens or even to enjoy the delights of attractions such as the Lawnmower Museum! There are also a host of shops and arcades to explore.

Monday Following breakfast we travel to Seacombe, Liverpool to join our **Mersey Ferry Cruise** boat ready for a 6 hour cruise to Salford Quays, via the **Manchester Ship Canal**. It is a journey through time passing through locks and a succession of swing bridges mostly unchanged since they were built 100 years ago. An on board guide will provide commentary of what can be seen, and explain the history and extraordinary engineering that went into the building of this ship canal. There may be time for a look around **Salford Quays** before we return to Bradford for mid evening.
