

Glasgow & The Falkirk Wheel

Friday 21st - Sunday 23rd October 2011



Friday Departing Bradford at 08.00 we travel to Settle before we journey to **Dumfries** for our lunchtime break. Dumfries is an ancient town situated on the River Nith and has a long and turbulent history, not least as the location where Robert the Bruce murdered a rival to the Scottish crown. From here we travel to our hotel in Glasgow.

Saturday Today you are free to explore **Glasgow**, a wonderfully vibrant city. Attractions include the Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum, the Hunterian Museum (*admissions not included*) as well as a wide variety of shops.

Sunday We travel the short distance for our trip on the **Falkirk Wheel**. This millennium project is worlds only rotating boat lift, lifting 115 feet, and replacing a series of locks on the Union Canal. There is also a viewing gallery and exhibition, as well as a shop and café. We then travel home, with a stop at Moffatt and Westmoreland Services, arriving in Bradford mid evening.
