**Sunday** - Departing from Bradford at 9.30am we will travel across the North Yorkshire Moors and on to the picturesque resort of **Whitby** with its ruined cliff-top abbey, narrow alleys and shops, fish and chips and the colourful boats in the harbour. Then later in the afternoon we continue down the coast to **Scarborough** and our hotel with it's wonderful views where dinner awaits.
