



Sunday Depart Bradford at 9.30 we travel to **Thirsk** for a break before viewing the world famous **Middlesbrough Transporter Bridge** on the River Tees, then on to **Ormesby Hall**. The hall is a classic Georgian mansion and has been home to the Pennyman family for nearly 400 years, and has beautiful gardens set in an 18th century landscape. Ormesby was also the home of "wicked" Sir James Pennyman, famous for his extravagant lifestyle and gambling. From here we travel to our hotel.

Monday We depart from **Scarborough** late morning to give you a chance to look round the resort, and visit **Beverley**, an attractive market town with a wide range of individual shops, as well as the famous minster. From here we travel back to Bradford, with a view of the **Humber Bridge** and river on the way. Back for early evening
