

## Blists Hill Museum and the Severn Valley Railway

Sat 31st Mar - Sun 1st Apr 2012



**Saturday** Departing Bradford at 9.00 we travel, with a stop en route, to **Blists Hill Open Air Museum**, which is part of the Ironbridge Gorge complex of museums. Here an entire working town has been recreated and peopled with characters from the nineteenth century who bring it back to life with demonstrations and dramatic presentations. Amongst the attractions are a sweetshop, bakery, school and bank. From here we travel to our hotel and dinner.

**Sunday** We travel to **Bridgnorth** with its attractive range of individual shops, and small but beautiful garden set in the grounds of the ruined castle. We, then, join the **Severn Valley Railway** for the scenic trip to Kidderminster. From here we travel home, arriving in Bradford early evening.

### The Hotel
