Thursday Depart Bradford 09.30 calling at **Settle**, en route to **Heysham** and the late lunchtime sailing to **Douglas** and our hotel.

Friday Full day excursion **with a Local Guide**. We visit **Laxey** for a view of **Lady Isabella**, the world's largest working waterwheel, before heading to **Ramsey**, the main town on the north of the island.

Saturday Half day excursion **with a Local Guide** across the island to the typically Manx town of **Peel**. Included is a tour of **Moore's Traditional Working Museum** where the curing of Manx kippers can be witnessed. The afternoon will be free for you to enjoy the town of **Douglas**.

Sunday Tour the south of the island with a visit to the ancient capital of **Castletown**. We continue to the south west corner and a visit to **Cregneash Village Folk Museum**. Nearby are wonderful views around Calf Sound and the village of Port Erin.

Monday An early morning start to catch the ferry, arriving back in **Heysham** for lunch time. We will have a few hours in **Morecambe**, before returning to Bradford for early evening.
