

Bronze Age to Steam Age

Mon 9th - Thu 12th Apr 2012



Monday Departing Bradford at 9.00 we travel, with a stop en route, to **Burghley House**, one of the great Elizabethan houses of England and still inhabited by the descendants of the first owner. A true 'Treasure House', it also has interesting gardens. From here we travel to our hotel.

Tuesday We travel to **Flag Fen Archaeology Park**, home of a Bronze Age monument as well as reconstructed buildings from the Bronze and Iron ages. We then travel to the nearby Georgian market town of **Wisbech** for a lunch time stop which has been described as having the most perfect Georgian streets in England.

Wednesday Today we travel to Wansford to join the **Nene Valley Railway** where we will enjoy a return trip to Peterborough. We then return to **Peterborough** to enable you to explore the city with its 900 year old cathedral.

Thursday We visit **Rutland Water** where we will enjoy a cruise which will include a landing at **Normanton Church** which was saved from the waves . We then visit **Oakham**, the county town of Rutland. We then journey home arriving in Bradford early evening.

The Hotel
