

Scottish Railways

Monday 30th July - Friday 3rd August 2012



Monday Departing Bradford at 07.30 we travel north with stops en route arriving at our hotel early evening.

Tuesday We take a scenic drive to **Fort William** where we enjoy a trip on the **Jacobite Steam Train**, along part of the **West Highland line** between **Fort William** and the fishing port of **Mallaig** (*this is a one way journey either joining the train in Fort William or for the return journey in Mallaig*). This is, rightly, regarded as one of the worlds great railway journeys taking in stunning scenery and the Glenfinnan Monument on the banks of Loch Shiel where Bonnie Prince Charlie raised his standard in 1745. We then return to our hotel for the evening.

Wednesday We travel to **Inverness** where we join the train for the spectacular journey across Scotland to the **Kyle of Lochalsh** taking in breathtaking views of lochs and mountains. From Kyle, by coach, we travel to **Spean Bridge**, stopping at the Commando Monument. Returning to the hotel we pass through "Monarch of the Glen" country.

Thursday Today we drive the short distance to **Aviemore**, where there will be time to explore the resort and shops before we join the **Strathspey Steam train**, which takes us from **Aviemore to Broomhill**. Broomhill is currently most famous as "Glenbogle" in "Monarch of the Glen". We then travel to a **Distillery** for a guided tour and a wee dram. There will be free time in **Grantown on Spey** before we travel back to our hotel for our final dinner with Scottish entertainment.

Friday We travel to **Perth** where there will be time to visit the numerous shops and attractions before we continue our journey south. Stopping as necessary, we aim to return to Bradford for late evening.
