

Cornish Rail and Sail

Monday 6th August - Friday 10th August 2012

Monday Departing from Bradford 8.00, we travel with stops en route to **St Austell**.

Tuesday Today we travel to **Bodmin** for a train journey on the **Bodmin Steam Railway**. From here, we travel to the seaside resort of **Newquay** in time for lunch and free time in the town. We then travel to visit the golden sands of the 19th century tin mining village of **Perranporth** where you will have a chance to explore.

Wednesday We first travel to the picturesque fishing village of **Mevagissey**, rightly regarded as one of the most scenic places in Cornwall, where you will have time to explore the seafronts and shops. We, then, travel to **Fowey**, designated as an Area of Natural Beauty, with its natural harbour which is popular with fishermen and sailors. The town was home to Daphne Du Maurier and boasts an excellent selection of shops and galleries.



Thursday We start the day with time in **Falmouth** where you have some free time to explore before we take a **boat journey to Truro** allowing you to view the spectacular Falmouth Harbour and the River Fal. You can enjoy a sailor's view of St Just, Trelissick and Tolverne. In **Truro** you will have a chance to explore the cobbled streets before we return to the hotel.

Friday We travel home, via the market town of **Evesham**, which has a range of attractions including individual shops and an attractive waterside park. We arrive back in Bradford mid evening.
