

A Taste of the Black Forest

Friday 7th - Friday 14th September 2012

Friday Departing Bradford at 10.00 we travel to **York**, for a lunchtime stop before we travel to Hull to catch the overnight ferry to Zeebrugge.

Saturday. Arrive in Zeebrugge and travel with stops as required to **Obenhammersbach**.

Sunday Today we enjoy a superb introductory tour of the **Black Forest**, stopping first at the attractive city of **Freiburg** dominated by its Gothic Minster, the Schlossberg and the remains of three castles perched over the city. We continue along the scenic Schauinsland and Feldberg roads to the beautiful lakeside resort of **Titisee**, including a **short lake cruise with coffee and black forest gateaux**.

Monday Our drive through the **Kinzig and Elz Valleys** to **St Peter**, where you may wish to visit the beautiful baroque church. We then travel to **Furtwangen**, home of the German Cuckoo Clock Museum. Next stop is **Triberg**, home of the highest waterfalls in Germany as well as the Black Forest museum, with the world's largest collection of barrel organs. (*Admissions not included*).

Tuesday Today we cross the border into **Switzerland** where we visit the spectacular **Rhine Falls near Scaffhausen**. We also visit **Scaffhausen**, an attractive medieval town, presided over by the Munot Fortress. From here we travel to **Blumberg** for a ride on the "**Sauschwanzlebahn**" (pigtail train), one of the most famous steam trains in Germany, where you can enjoy the spectacular scenery.



Wednesday Today you are free to enjoy our resort of **Oberharmerbach**, which is situated in the heart of the Black Forest.

Thursday. Return journey to **Zeebrugge** and the overnight ferry back to Hull. If time permits we will call at the delightful city of **Brugge**.

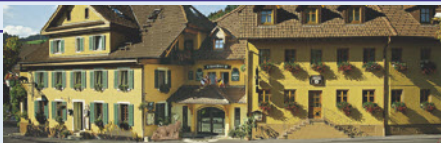
Friday Disembarking at Hull we make our way home to arrive mid morning.
